

## Dean of Work Education

College of the Ozarks seeks applicants for the Dean of Work Education position. The Dean of Work Education is responsible for the leadership of the Work Education Program, a defining feature of the educational philosophy and student experience at College of the Ozarks. Students work approximately 15 hours each week (with two 40-hour work weeks per year) at one of more than 80 campus workstations to offset the cost of their tuition.

Applicants should demonstrate a strong vision for developing the Work Education Program and integrating it with the academic and student life programs. The position requires frequent communication with workstation supervisors and students and a dedication to workstation supervisor training and development. Applicants should have the ability to lead and manage a large team and must be willing to work with departments across campus to further the rich legacy of student work at College of the Ozarks.
